




Windbreak alone on windy days

Use two of the extra vertical poles and place them in the middle against the back of your windbreak

Use one of the guy lines to tie this to the ground. Doing this reduces the forces on the outside vertical poles and will ensure the windbreak can withstand stronger winds

Optimum use of sand pegs



Wrap excess string around peg

Place peg all the way into the sand

Ensure guy line goes over the top of the peg


end caps

Six Pole Configuration

This is a good configuration for when the sun is nearer to the horizon. You only require 6 vertical

Due to the angle of the "end caps", the vertical poles may want to be on a slight angle. This is not a problem and reduces strain on the

Wrap excess guy line string around the sand peg, then place the guy line over the groove at the top of the peg as per the picture on the bottom of page 6


If the breeze has picked up during the day with the Canopy Support in place, you can easily remove the Canopy Support to get the cover into this configuration

Canopy Set-up on windy days


On windy days, such as a strong sea breeze, Beachshadow is best used without the canopy
